NCLB PARENTS RIGHT TO KNOW

As a parent of a student in the the Byram Hills Central School District, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teacher(s) who instruct your child. The Federal law, No Child Left Behind, allows you to ask certain information about your child's classroom teacher(s), and requires school districts to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teacher(s):

1. Whether the teacher has NYS Education Department license or certification for the classes he or she teaches, or whether the teacher can be qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
2. The teacher's college major and any other certifications or advanced degrees by field or discipline.
3. The qualifications of any teaching aides who provide services to your child, if applicable.
