

SAMANTHA MILEWICZ NAMED REGENERON SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH FINALIST

Congratulations to Byram Hills High School senior **Samantha Milewicz** on being chosen as a finalist in the prestigious Regeneron Science Talent Search! Samantha is one of 40 finalists and will participate in a week-long event in March. These students will compete for more than \$1.8 million, with a top prize of \$250,000.

Samantha used a novel 3D model that mimics the brain's protective layer, the blood-brain barrier, to identify a protein involved in tissue damage from traumatic brain injuries. With a combination of several techniques, she demonstrated that inhibiting the production of the protein MMP-9 restores healthy barrier function postinjury, providing insight into this protein's potential for therapeutic innovation.

SAMANTHA SCHAEVITZ RECEIVED THE NEUROSCIENCE RESEARCH PRIZE

Congratulations to BHHS senior Samantha Schaevitz on being selected to receive the Neuroscience Research Prize! This award is designed to encourage high school students to explore the world of the brain and nervous system through research and reward those whose scientific skill and talent indicate the potential for scientific contributions in neuroscience. Samantha investigated the use of focused ultrasound with microbubbles as a method to improve brain cancer treatment by allowing therapeutic drugs to more easily pass through the blood-brain barrier, a protective layer for the brain. She found that increasing ultrasonic pressure with microbubbles demonstrated a noticeable increase in drug penetration deep into the cancerous tumor. With further investigation, this method of drug delivery could hold promising potential as a more effective brain cancer treatment.

Samantha is invited to attend the American Academy of Neurology annual conference in Boston to present her work this spring.

If your child tests positive for Covid:

 Your child must stay home for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home.

(Note: If your child has no symptoms, Day 0 is the day that they test positive. If your child has symptoms, Day 0 is the day of their first symptoms).

Ending isolation:

- Your child **may not** end isolation if symptoms are not improving.
- Your child may end isolation after Day 5 if symptoms are improving and your child is fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.
- Your child must wear a mask through Day 10 at home and in public, including at school.
