






ELSA ROLFS' ARTWORK SELECTED FOR THE 2023 NATIONAL K-12 CLAY EXHIBITION

The Fine Arts Department proudly announces that junior Elsa Rolfs' work has been selected for the 2023 National K-12 Clay exhibition. This show is in conjunction with the annual conference of the National Council on Education for the Ceramics Arts (NCECA). The conference attracts the most talented clay artists and has approximately 4,000 members in the U.S. and participants from over 20 other countries. The K-12 clav show will be held in Cincinnati this year from March 15-17. Elsa's piece, an ocarina in the form of a human heart. is one of only 152 pieces selected from more than 1,300 submissions.

MARCH

March 17th - Online form due and hard copy of transportation and medical emergency release form due in the main office.

APRIL

Sites should be secured at this time. Students who do not have sites will meet with Mrs. Croke and Mr. August. The last formal meeting with students during office hours are on **April 17th** and **April 18th**.

There will be an after-school meeting on **April 18th**. Students must attend one of these sessions.

All academic obligations should be fulfilled before leaving for internship.

COVID GUIDELINES UPDATE

Please follow the CDC guidelines for Covid. The website can be found **here.**

If your child tests positive for Covid:

- Your child must stay home for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home.

(Note: If your child has no symptoms, Day 0 is the day they test positive. If your child has symptoms, Day 0 is the day of their first symptoms).

Ending isolation:

- Your child **may not** end isolation if symptoms are not improving.
- Your child may end isolation after Day 5 if symptoms are improving and your child is feverfree for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.
- Your child must wear a mask through Day 10 at home and in public, including at school.


