To the Byram Hills School Community,

You may have heard that Howard Zucker, NYS Commissioner of Health, wrote a <u>letter to the CDC</u> on Friday seeking guidance on a plan to change the mask mandate in schools. Please read the letter, which argues for encouraging but not requiring masks in schools, except under high risk circumstances.

I know that there are people who stand on both sides of the mask mandate issue - some who worry for the safety of their families if exposed to unvaccinated people - and others who do not think the same way and want their children to take their masks off - vaccinated or not. I do worry about the potential for mass quarantines with a few weeks left to the year. I also know that many are vaccinated adults and older students and that transmission rates outside are negligible. I will share these thoughts with the Board.

I will continue to watch for guidance this weekend from Howard Zucker. The District will also need to see guidance on who needs to quarantine under the new guidance when a COVID positive case is identified. We have end of the year celebrations, school, camp, and individual health to consider.

The BOARD OF EDUCATION and I will discuss the potential lifting of the mask mandate at the Board of Education meeting on Tuesday, if new guidance is available, and I will report back to the community on Wednesday with the District decision if one can be made at that time.
