To the Byram Hills School Community,

This afternoon, we were informed of two COVID-19 positive cases; one at Byram Hills High School and one at HCC Middle School. There are 25 students at Byram Hills High School and 30 students at HCC who are in quarantine.

These cases appear to be isolated and the DOH may begin contact tracing, although the 14-day quarantine notice from the school suffices as notification from the DOH.

We are expecting that the CDC will issue new guidelines about the number of days a person must remain in quarantine, as per the news today. The new guidance has a 10 day quarantine period with an option for a 7 day release with a negative test. We will continue to keep you informed and will adjust quarantine dates when the new guidance becomes available.

I will be conducting Superintendent Coffees this week to talk more about COVID-19 testing, quarantine, and how the District continues to manage our schools.
