*Additional Notes:*

1. Counselors will check AP course requests during the week of January 18.
2. Chairs and faculty will add their course recommendations for math, science, and world language in February.
3. Counselors will check math, science, and world language recommendations during the last week of February.
4. Students will add their electives using the student portal of eSD in late-February and in early-to-mid-March. **Fact Sheet 2** will be available on the Course Selection Website and it includes electives.
5. Counselors will check all course requests beginning on March 18.
6. All course requests will be available for students and parents in the last week of April via the portal in eSD.
7. Final schedules will be available via the parent portal in eSD on/about August 12.
